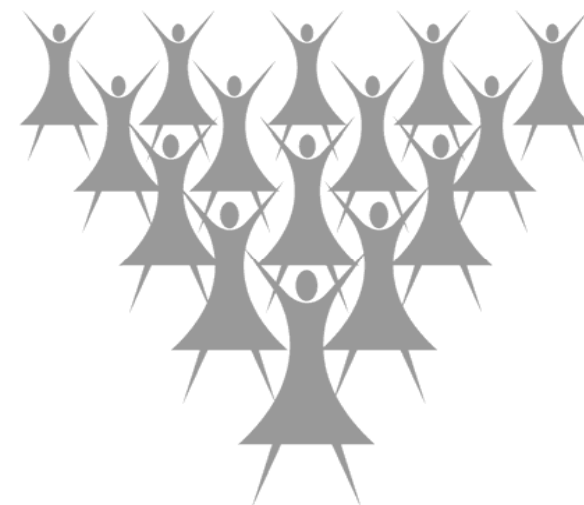

Women's

Women have always recognized the value of relationships – in the home, in the workplace and in the community. Now they can use their relationships to shape their philanthropy.

THE WOMEN'S PHILANTHROPY NETWORK is a community of philanthropic women who leverage their charitable assets in order to make high-impact gifts that effect positive change in the Shreveport-Bossier area.

Through the WPN, women can

- **Create new solutions to old problems**
- **Serve as a catalyst for positive community change**
- **Connect with the projects they fund**
- **Collaborate with others to avoid duplication, competition and waste**
- **Celebrate their accomplishments and have fun with philanthropy**

Philanthropy

As a group, members learn about local needs and issues, then support projects that will make a significant difference in meeting those needs. Every member has a voice and vote in recommending how the funds will be spent.

The goal of the WPN is a bold one: raise at least \$100,000 annually. Each year, 80% of the membership dues will be used as “now” money for one major project; 20% will be deposited into an endowment account to benefit future generations. Because the WPN is an advised fund of The Community Foundation of Shreveport-Bossier, the Foundation will oversee the endowment and will assist with administrative duties.

Throughout the year there will be opportunities to find out about the important issues facing our community through “Lunch and Learns” and once a year we will come together to celebrate our successes and plan for the future .

Network

Membership is comprised of women who make a tax-deductible gift of at least \$500 annually. There are four levels of giving:

\$500 - \$999 – “Ruby”

\$1,000 - \$2,499 – “Sapphire”

\$2,500 - \$4,999 – “Emerald”

\$5,000 or more – “Diamond”

In addition, there is a special membership category of \$200.00 for women 16-29 years of age.
